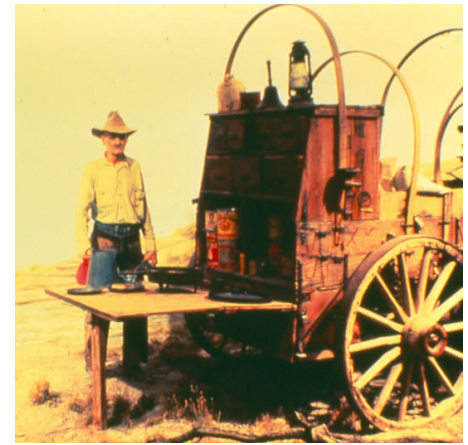


CANYONS, COWBOYS, AND CADILLACS
