

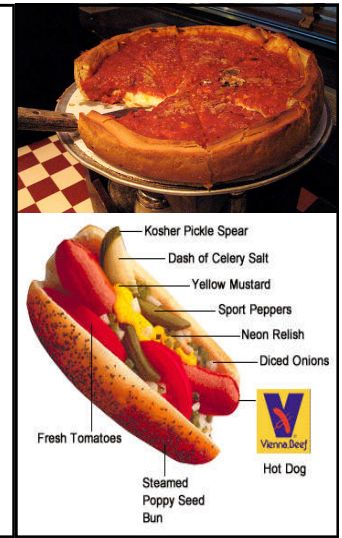

Museum of Science and Industry (included): Named one of the 15 great museums in the world by LIFE magazine, the Museum of Science and Industry invites visitors to experience a real-to-life coal mine, WW II submarine, virtual reality optional Omnimax films -- and much more.

Sears Tower Skydeck (included): Taller than the Empire State Building, the views are the best of Chicago - and beyond.

Shedd Aquarium (included): The Aquarium contains several exhibits, the most notable are the Caribbean Reef (90,000 gallons) and the Oceanarium (3 million gallons).

Adler Planetarium (included): The Adler Planetarium is the United States' first planetarium, and features two full-size planetarium theaters.

Navy Pier (included): The Navy Pier is home to many attractions. The most eye-catching are the 148 ft Ferris Wheel and the 44 ft high musical carousel with 36 hand-painted animals. It's home to the world's largest stained glass museum and is a wonderful place to watch Chicago's famous fireworks, schedule permitting.

Lake Cruise (included): You'll enjoy a truly different view of Chicago's famous sky scrapers highlighted by the setting sun as you enjoy an evening cruise on Lake Michigan, with dinner included.

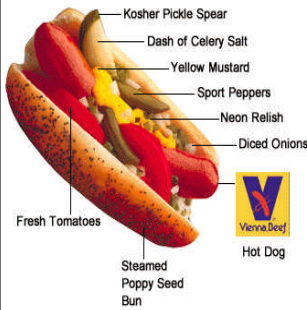

CHICAGO DEEP DISH PIZZA

Chicago. That's the first thing you are going to think of with regard to Deep Dish Pizza, and you are right. It's Chicago where it was first created and it's Chicago where it's most popular. Actually, Deep Dish Pizza is to Chicago what chili is to Cincinnati. There are more than 2,000 pizzerias in Chicago, most of them serving "deep dish" and many of them offshoots of a small original kitchen in an old part of town. The story that has not been disputed is that a Texan named Ike Sewell created the dish at his bar and grill named Pizzeria Uno in 1943. The pizza was so popular that to handle the crowds he had to open another place nearby called Pizzeria Due. By 1955 a restaurant just east of Michigan Avenue began serving deep dish pizza in a place called Gino's East, and it became popular with the crowds along Chicago's "Magnificent Mile."



CHICAGO HOT DOG (It's different)

The "Chicago Style" hot dog got its start from street cart hot dog vendors during the hard times of the Great Depression. Money was scarce, but business was booming for these entrepreneurs who offered a delicious hot meal on a bun for only a nickel. The famous Chicago Style Hot Dog was born! They'd start with a Vienna Beef hot dog, nestle it in a steamed poppyseed bun and cover it with a wonderful combination of toppings: yellow mustard, bright green relish, fresh chopped onions, juicy red tomato wedges, a kosher-style pickle spear, a couple of spicy sport peppers and finally, a dash of celery salt. This unique hot dog creation with a "salad on top" and its memorable interplay of hot and cold, crisp and soft, sharp and smooth, became America's original fast food and a true Chicago institution.



BERGHOFF - FAMOUS CHICAGO GERMAN FOOD

Since Carlyn Berghoff opened 17/West at the Berghoff in 2006, in the space formerly occupied by her family's 107-year-old restaurant, she has defined 'tradition with a twist,' enhancing modern dishes while keeping her family's classic meals.
