Day 1 Comfortable flights take us to Maine, where we will be transported to nearby Bar Harbor, getting our first eye level glimpses of colorful foliage en route. After checking in we will get situated and relax in our oceanfront rooms.

Day 2 Following a relaxing and bountiful **Maine Continental Breakfast** (included daily) overlooking Frenchman's Bay, nearby **Acadia National Park** will be experienced. Opened in 1916, Acadia was the first national park east of the Mississippi, and was the first national park whose land was donated entirely by private citizens. 360-degree panoramic views will be enjoyed from on top of Cadillac Mountain; at 1,530 feet the highest peak on the Atlantic Coast north of Brazil. **Popovers and Tea**, an Acadia tradition, will be enjoyed at Jordan's Pond. Later this evening enjoy a **Welcome Lobster Bake**, featuring chowder, clams, lobster, blueberry pie, and tea or coffee.

Day 3 Bar Harbor is located on Mt. Desert Island. Today, new

areas will be enjoyed, including a scenic drive to; and an up-close view of, one of Maine's many lighthouses -- the famous **Bass Harbor Head Light**. The subject of many photographs and paintings, this famous lighthouse is one of more than 65 found along Maine's shoreline (only Michigan has more). Fall-foliage covered hills and roadways will take us to exciting out-of-the-way places. Also, enjoy included **lobster boat ride** (weather permitting) while learning about this unusual crop from the sea.

Day 4 Enjoy a day of sightseeing and outlet shopping. Maine is the home of the likes of **L.L. Bean** and **Dexter Shoes** (many pairs are always purchased by tour members at money-saving prices). **Rockport, Camden** (home of Edna St. Vincent Millay), **Maine's beautiful coastline** south of Bar Harbor, and a **Maine Made Products Center** will be explored.

Day 5 **Sunrise in North America can first be seen from atop Cadillac Mountain**. Offered for the especially energetic, this no-cost optional activity can be breathtaking. Also, beautiful red and white striped **West Quoddy Lighthouse** just south of the Canadian border will be experienced. Large colorful rolling **fields of blueberry plants** and **cranberry bogs** will be viewed "up close".

Day 7 Time for last-minute shopping, relaxation (we'll show you where to get Blueberry Ale and Hubcaps), and some Maine surprises, are in store, followed by a **Farewell Dinner** featuring succulent selections of foods from Maine.
